A Divine Assignment: Umuahia Free Medical Outreach, 2025

The Umuahia Free Medical Outreach 2025 was carried out as a solemn and purposeful response to a divine assignment, centered on the theme “My Father’s Business.” Through the generous partnership of our donors and stakeholders, Greatstory International was able to extend quality medical services to the sick, poor, and needy families in Umuahia.



Throughout the outreach, there was a profound sense of God’s presence, evident not only in the effectiveness of the medical interventions delivered, but also in the atmosphere of compassion, order, and dignity with which services were rendered. Resources entrusted to us were translated into tangible outcomes: care for the sick, relief for the burdened through free surgeries, and salvation for unbelievers within the community.

Registration Unit:

The Registration Unit successfully registered **1,396 individuals**, serving as the primary entry point into the outreach. Through orderly documentation and efficient coordination, the unit ensured smooth patient flow, accurate record-keeping, and effective linkage to subsequent medical services, enabling the outreach to operate seamlessly.



Vital Signs Unit:

The Vital Signs Unit attended to **3,396 patients** during the outreach, providing essential preliminary assessments that formed the foundation for effective medical care. Precise measures and notes on vital signs sped up patient sorting. They ensured right referrals and smooth services. This helped the outreach succeed.

Counselling Unit:

The Counselling Unit engaged with **1,287 individuals**, with the gospel of Jesus Christ, prayers and the power of God. Notably, **708 people made a decision to receive Christ**, marking a significant spiritual impact and reflecting the profound work accomplished through counsel, prayer, and the evident presence of God during the outreach.



Laboratory Unit:

A total of **798 patients** were attended to through essential diagnostic services such as HIV test, HCV, HBsAg, H.pylori, etc, supporting accurate medical evaluation and informed clinical decisions. These services played a critical role in effective patient care, ensuring timely detection, proper referrals, and improved treatment outcomes during the outreach.



Children Unit:

Our children unit had a total of 162 children that received attentive and dedicated care, including the gospel, medical check-ups, personalized assessments, and gifts. This careful

attention created a safe and nurturing environment, ensuring the youngest participants felt valued, comfortable, and well-cared-for throughout the outreach.

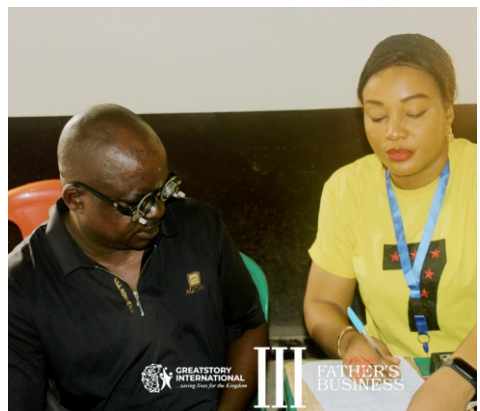


Ophthalmic Care Unit Unit:

At the Greatstory Free Medical Outreach in Umuahia, the Eye Unit played a vital role in restoring vision and improving quality of life for the community. The team conducted thorough eye examinations, identified various vision challenges, and provided expert guidance on maintaining healthy eyesight. **A remarkable 1710 pairs of corrective glasses were distributed**, giving countless patient, from 35 years and above the gift of clear sight.

Beyond clinical care, the unit engaged patients with practical advice on eye health, from proper eye hygiene to preventive measures against common

eye conditions. The compassionate and dedicated team ensured that every individual received personalized attention in a safe, welcoming environment.



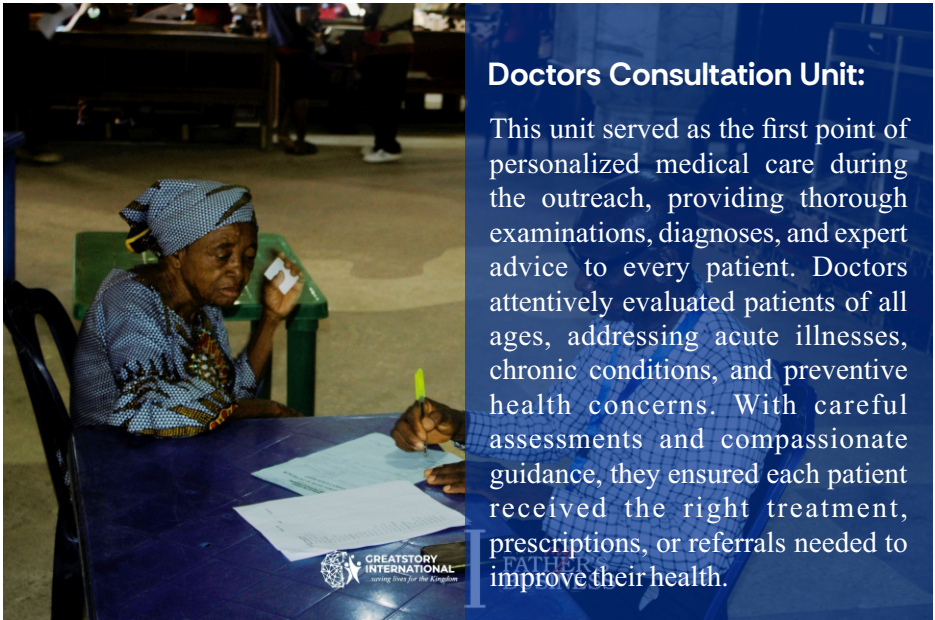
Pharmacy Unit:

The Pharmacy Unit ensured that **1826 patients** received the medicines they needed, along with clear guidance on proper usage. Essential drugs for common illnesses and chronic conditions were dispensed efficiently, empowering patients to continue their recovery at home. Through attentive care and expert advice, the team turned every prescription into a step toward healing, wellness, and lasting health for the community.



Dental Unit:

The Dental Unit provided essential oral care to the community. During the outreach, **47 tooth extractions** were carefully performed, relieving pain and restoring oral health, while **25 patients** received preventive care, check-ups, and guidance on proper dental hygiene. Smiles were brightened, discomfort eased, and patients left not only with healthier teeth but also with knowledge and confidence to maintain good oral care at home.



Doctors Consultation Unit:

This unit served as the first point of personalized medical care during the outreach, providing thorough examinations, diagnoses, and expert advice to every patient. Doctors attentively evaluated patients of all ages, addressing acute illnesses, chronic conditions, and preventive health concerns. With careful assessments and compassionate guidance, they ensured each patient received the right treatment, prescriptions, or referrals needed to improve their health.

Welfare Unit:

The Welfare Unit ensured that all 95 volunteers were fed. Each volunteer received wholesome meals thrice a day till the end of the outreach. Also, suitable rest areas (hotel accommodations) for 70 volunteers for five days.



Surgical Interventions

Amid the hustle of the Greatstory Free Medical Outreach, one patient's story stood out, a woman who had been silently battling the relentless pain of fibroids for years. Daily life had become a struggle: simple tasks left her exhausted, sleep was often interrupted, and the constant discomfort weighed heavily on her spirit. Fear and financial constraints had kept her from seeking proper treatment... until the outreach offered hope.

At the Doctors Consultation Unit, her condition was carefully assessed, and arrangements were made for a fibroid removal surgery, completely free of charge. The procedure was performed with expert care, and for the first time in years, she left the hospital relieved, pain-free, and filled with gratitude. Tears of joy streamed down her face as she realized she could finally live without the constant burden that had shadowed her life for so long.

Her story is a powerful reminder of why the outreach exists, to restore health, relieve suffering, and bring hope to those who need it most. Through acts of compassion and skilled medical care, lives like hers are

transformed.



The Surgical Unit provided life-changing interventions for 57 patients during the outreach, performing a wide range of procedures with precision and care. This included 9 myomectomies for women suffering from fibroids, 6 lipoma removals, 3 BSO + TAH procedures, 1 stitch granuloma correction, 36 hernia repairs, and 2 lumpectomies. Each surgery was conducted with expert attention, relieving pain, restoring health, and improving the quality of life for patients who had often struggled for years. The Surgical Unit not only treated illnesses but also brought comfort, relief, and a brighter outlook for Umuahia.

Eye Surgeries:

During the Just4Jesus Free Medical Outreach in Umuahia, the Eye Surgical Unit shone as a beacon of hope, performing cataract and pterygium extractions. Many patients who arrived with severe visual impairment, even some blind in one or both eyes, left the outreach rejoicing in newfound sight. In total, **68 patients underwent successful surgeries**, each experiencing the transformative gift of clearer vision and a renewed sense of independence.
